Guidelines for obtaining points

- 1. SMART Lunch:** To receive fifteen points for attending a SMART Lunch for assistance, students must
 - a. Attend a full 30 minute session
 - b. Be engaged in studying math. This may include but is not limited to
 - i. Completing Homework
 - ii. Correcting former tests
 - iii. Involved in an math study group
 - iv. Asking questions of instructor or other qualified students
 - v. Organizing/reviewing notes
 - vi. Completing Flash cards

- 2. Test Corrections** – To receive points for test corrections:
 - a. Students must use test corrections template provided by teacher.
 - b. Students must show all work leading to a complete correct answer.
 - c. Students must turn in test corrections during SMART lunch ONLY.

- 3. Review Day** – Up to teacher discretion.

- 4. Present a Problem** - To receive points for presenting a problem the problem must be accurately completed and the student must be able to explain in detail the solution to the problem for the entire class.

- 5. Miscellaneous** – Reason for awarding points and amount of points to be awarded will be up to teacher discretion.
